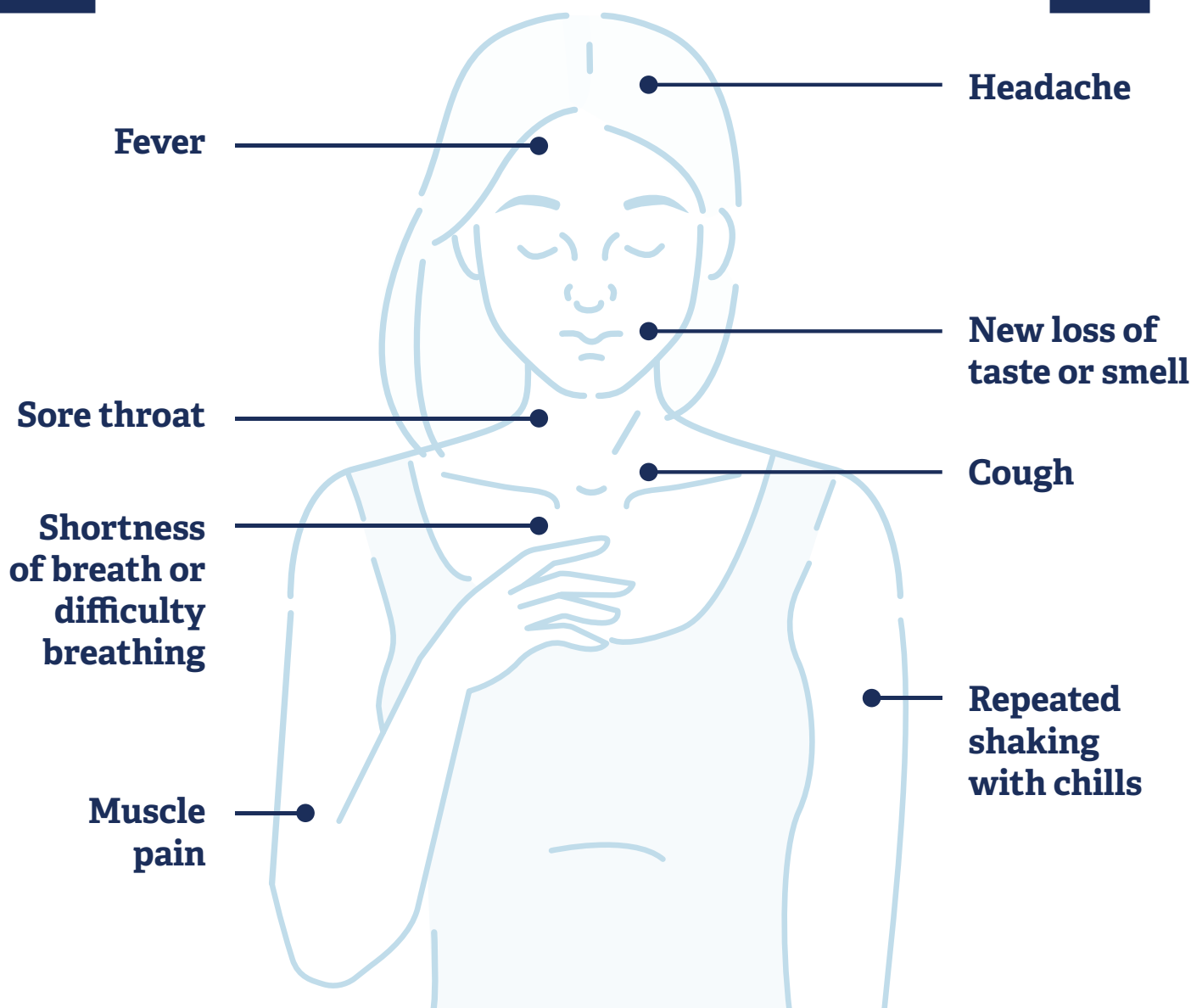


COVID-19: Spot the Symptoms

People with COVID-19 have had a wide range of symptoms reported
– ranging from mild symptoms to severe illness.

These symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus:



Most people with COVID-19 develop only mild symptoms, but people over 60 and those with other health conditions may develop more serious symptoms, including pneumonia and kidney failure. **If you suspect you have COVID-19, call your primary care provider or the Ohio Department of Health's public call center at 1 (833) 427-5634.**
