HOW DO I GET TESTED?

If experiencing symptoms,
you have options:

Call your doctor

Call an urgent care

Call your local health department

No symptoms?
You have options:

Retail sites, like pharmacies or drug stores, can do testing

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO: Many testing sites (including OhioHealth) require a provider's order to get tested. We do not recommend that people who only need COVID-19 tests visit our emergency departments. Our emergency departments are only equipped to provide COVID-19 testing in emergency care scenarios.
